Dear Friends,

It is a marker in the road of time that gives us a sense of how far we have come and how far yet there is to go along the way of life. I never cared much for the carousy way some like to celebrate the night, particularly the heavy drinking that somehow is seen as expected does nothing for me. On the other hand, the fireworks, especially here in Cuenca when the whole city explodes in way over-the-top pyrotechnic ecstasy does delight me. Last year, I watched from the balcony of the home of the Campoverde's and felt like a kid taking the magic all in! I got a terrific shot of three stars exploding over the three cupolas of the Cathedral that is a stunner.

Happily for those who go to bed early and could care less about any of it, there is a deep spiritual side to the first day of the new year that can be theirs with no hangover needed to take advantage of . It is for us Catholics a Holy Day solemnly celebrating Mary, the Mother of God. We have a lot of Mary feasts, but this one is particularly special and important because by proclaiming Mary as Mother of God, the Church is actually proclaiming her son, Jesus, as fully God and fully human.
