A Few Words from Father Kevin

Dear Friends,

If you have been paying attention to "church news" then you probably know that we are now in a "jubilee year". On May 9, 2024, Pope Francis formally announced the Holy Year in a document entitled, "Hope Does Not Disappoint". Such Jubilees come up every 25 years so they really are special years for the Church and its faithful. Obviously, the central theme of this year's Jubilee is that of *hope* and its central image is that of the Christian people being *pilgrims of hope* in our fractured world. Pope Francis' emphasis on the Holy Year being an opportunity to exercise our identity as pilgrims is of utmost imortance to him. In his declaration of the Jubilee, he writes:

Pilgrimage is of course a fundamental element of every Jubilee event. Setting out on a journey is traditionally associated with our human quest for meaning in life. A pilgrimage on foot is a great aid for rediscovering the value of silence, effort and simplicity of life. In the coming year, *pilgrims of hope* will surely travel the ancient and more modern routes in order to experience the Jubilee to the full. Journeying from one country to another as if borders no longer mattered, and passing from one city to another in contemplating the beauty of creation and masterpieces of art, we learn to treasure the richness of different experiences and cultures, and are inspired to lift up that beauty, in prayer, to God, in thanksgiving for his wondrous works. The Jubilee Churches along the pilgrimage routes and in the city of Rome can serve as oases of spirituality and places of rest on the pilgrimage of faith, where we can drink from the wellsprings of hope, above all by approaching the sacrament of Reconciliation, the essential starting-point of any true journey of conversion.

Perhaps in the coming year we can as a church family find a way to walk together as pilgrims, maybe even just here in the city, ending at the Cathedral and passing through its Holy Door. Let's think about that!
