Dear Friends,

On this Fourth Sunday of Advent, Mary finally appears as the star of our Gospel readings! Luke's version of her visit to the home of her cousin, Elizabeth is filled with some of the most sublime moments in the entire gospel story. The obvious love these two women have for each other is beautiful and their joy in meeting is a joy for us who read the story so many centuries later. Both are doing their part to fulfill God's plan of salvation, both are willing and gracious recipeints of God's surprising grace, both are vessels of God's blessings made flesh among us.

The gospel stories of Mary stand on their own; they are in themselves filled with great lessons for all of us, especially in these final days of the Advent season and those of Christmas to come. Nevertheless, it can be inspiring to see how others re-tell the story especially using modern technology. One such effort is the newly released film on Netflix simply titled: *Mary.* If you have some time in the next few days, it is worth taking a look. I was surprised how closely the film's storyline hews to the original gospel version, but also intrigued by some of the creative ways they added "backstory" to the characters. For example, the "Flight into Egypt" adds a violent encounter between Mary, Joseph, and their hosts along the way when the troops of evil Herod catch up to them.

Even more intriguing for me was they way the movie portrayed the angel Gabriel, who is a central figure throughout. It was like no other "Gabriel" I have ever seen in art or even my own imagination, yet this Gabriel seemed entirely real and a figure to be paid attention to. Likewise, the satan character was truly loathsome and frightning...enough to give a person an unwelcome nightmare.


I am happy Netflix decided to stream this movie. It might bring some people to a new love of Mary, Joseph, and most importantly, Jesus himself.
