A Few Words from Father Kevin

Dear Friends,

The liturgical season of Advent tends to get lost under the onslaught of our now deeply commercialized "Christmas season". Anthing we can do to keep Advent in people's hearts and minds amid these weeks of "Christmas Spirit" is all to the good.

The familiar statue here in Cuenca of Very Pregant Mary is a good start. It reminds me of my time in Saint Patrick Parish in Walla Walla, Washington. I suggested to a very creative lady in the parish that we hoist a large banner in the side chapel of the parish church of Mary standing in profile. I then asked if there was any way we could change the image week after week so that as the Advent season carried on, her pregancy would increasingly show. Thelma said she thought it was a great idea and got to work on her sewing machine putting together the pieces of cloth that would become our version of Increasingly Pregnant Mary. Before the First Sunday of Advent, the violet banner went up and many were touched by the pensive Mary looking slightly downward at her barely protruding belly. The next week, the cloth piece in that area was replaced making her belly slightly greater. Few noticed. By the Third Sunday of Advent, her pregnancy was really showing and people caught on and were delighted. On the Fourth Sunday, poor Mary looked like she was carrying twins and the people couldn't help but comment on how difficult her pregnancy was looking and, especially the mothers in the church, could only feel great compassion for the birth that was soon to follow. On Christmas Eve, before the evening Masses began, the entire banner was changed out, replaced with white background and a resplendant Mary facing forward holding the Christ Child in her loving arms!

It worked! Many parishioners told us often that Advent really felt like an Advent of preparation for the Nativity that year as they joined Mary in preparing for the birth of the Christ child!
