A Few Words from Father Kevin

Dear Friends,

On April 15, 2019, five years ago, a fire somehow got started in the extensive timbers holding up the roof of Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris. Before long, great damage had been done to the medieval building including the dramatic fall of its magnificent spire. Thanks to the heroic efforts of Parisian firefighters, much of the building and its treasures were saved, but just barely. At the time, President Macron declared that France would rebuild the Cathedral as it had been in just five years; most thought his goal would be impossible and he was crazy to propose it.

Yet, here we are, five years later, and the magnificent Cathedral of Notre Dame is now fully restored, never more resplendent in its gothic majesty. Over the past weekend it was reopened with two services, one on Saturday evening with politicians and national leaders from around the world present. The Arcbishop of Paris came to the massive doors of the Cathedral, then wielding his crozier at the doors, knocked three times, then again, and yet again, before he then single-handedly pushed them open!

The next morning, the first Mass was said in the Cathedral, again presided over by Archbishop Ulrich, and what a sublime and perfect liturgy it was! Particularly moving was the consecration of the new altar, made of dark bronze and shaped like an "U"; it is a very contemporary design, but somehow fits in the gothic space as if it were being cradled there by the church. Arcbhbishop Ulrich first placed holy relics of the saints into its interior, then lavishly and tenderly poured Sacred Chrism over the surface of the altar in great quantities, then spread the oil about with gentle hand movements. Thereafter, five braziers were placed upon it within which incense was placed and the whole altar began to send heavenward the perfumed smoke that signifies our prayers and sacrifices rising to heaven.

In its entirety it was a sublime liturgy and a model of how the "new liturgy" of Paul VI should be celebrated. If you want to know what our Catholic liturgy in this post-Vatican II era should look like: this is it. (Videos of it all are available on YouTube, of course; they are worth watching!)
