## Dear Friends,

Having celebrated Thanksgiving this past Thursday, a couple post-feast thoughts come to mind on this grand *fiesta* of gratitude.

As we all know, "the first Thanksgiving" was a meal shared among first settlers and native peoples to give thanks to God for the blessings of life and food, harvests and daily bread, survival and flourishing. It bode well for a gracious and mutually supportive relationship between both groups, the natives and the immigrants; sadly, over the years, prejudice and racism have marred that relationship in many places. But the heart of the feast has survived those ups and downs; the foundational inspiration of Thanksgiving has always been one of giving thanks to the God who created the dirt, the seed, the water, and all of us. There is no giving of thanks without the ONE to whom the thanks is being given. I am not sure to whom our non-believing friends give thanks to ... certainly more than the cook in the kitchen or the purveyer of turkeys. The feast is emptied of its deepest meaning if it is only that...grateful as we may be for farmers, good cooks, and those who stay late to wash the dishes. The very feast of Thanksgiving with all its warm and lovely customs and culinary traditions is an evangelizing event because it calls all of us, even our non-believing friends, to consider the Giver from whom all gifts flow.

Giving thanks is a salutary practice. It keeps us from sinking into an internal morass of self-pity. It lifts our eyes beyond ourselves. It binds us together in shared praise of the bounty we are blessed with day in and day out.

And now, we move on from Thanksgiving...not to Christmas yet...but to Advent and our great hope of Christ's coming. *Come, Lord Jesus, come!*
