Dear Friends,

Happy New Year and many blessings to you all in 2025! This weekend's Solemnity of the Epiphany reminds me of how the Christmas season seemed to wrap itself up so wonderfully when at last we were allowed to place the Three Magi into our family's Christmas Nativity scene. They had been traveling about the house for a week or so...always so much fun to decide where next they would land...until finally they arrived at the crib of Jesus.

It didn't really occur to us that we were participatig in the great mystery of Christmas: the Incarnation of our God among us, a mystery that has the power to touch *all humanity*, no matter the culture, nation, or spirituality. The three Magi who finally meet Jesus in Bethlehem today represent all those who search for truth, wisdom, and God himself. They represent all who keep their eyes open to the subtle signs of God, like that of a New Star beckoning them to leave home and travel as pilgrims towards New Life. The represent all who come from other lands and other cultures, traveling great distances, enduring the trials and dangers of the way to find something of heaven on this earth, though they know not what exactly.

I have a great respect and love for pilgrims like the Magi, having myself taken up the pilgrim Way to Santiago de Compostela on foot.
